- F.D is giving negative rate of interest.
- Investment option/methods:
 - Conventional (Gold, PO Savings, Traditional methods)
 - unconventional (REETS, ELSS, Index funds, etc.)
- F.D. 5.9% interest rate.
 - Tax 20%.
 - Post Tax Returns -6% * (1-0.2) = 4.8%
 - Inflation rate growing around 6 to 7%
 - Real rate of interest 4.8%-6.7% which is negative i.e., -1.9%
- Making charges on jewelries is a total loss for us a customer.





- Equity market/ share market (Avg CAGR: 20% approximately in 2011-21)
- Equity market is the only option which has given higher ration of return.
- Un conventional:
 - REETS.
 - Index funding.
 - Non convertible debentures.
 - SGP bonds.

- ETF is a type of Direct Investments.
- Index funds are for passive investors.
- Rule of 100: 100 Age
