
1. Mr. Jay Darji





How would you rate the overall structure of the Induction Program? 66 responses




How relevant were the topics covered during the Induction Program?




Which session did you find most beneficial?




How would you rate the Mr. Anup Munshi's knowledge for the session on "Campus to Corporate"?





How would you rate Mr. Anup Munshi's presentation skills for the session on "Campus to Corporate"?


How well did Mr. Anup Munshi's respond to questions from the audience? 66 responses






How would you rate the effectiveness of team building and ice-breaking activities of "Mastering The Art of Communication & Public Speaking"?




How would you rate Ms. Pritoria D'Mello's knowledge on the session of "Mastering The Art of Communication & Public Speaking"?






Highlight two major aspects of the Ms. Pritoria D'Mello? 66 responses



How would you rate the overall quality of the Faculty Interaction Sessions? 66 responses




How well did the faculty explain the program structure and curriculum? 66 responses




How engaging were the faculty members in the interaction session?


How satisfied are you with the insights provided by the faculty about the MMS program?


How would you rate the overall quality of the Alumni Interaction Sessions?


Were the alumni able to share valuable insights about their experiences and their career journey?


Did the alumni provide practical advice on industry trends, skills, and networking?


How satisfied are you with the insights provided by the alumni regarding career and industry expectations?
